Decision on Women's Ski Jumping Tomorrow – July 10!

- Deborah Folka, media advisor to the jumpers involved in the lawsuit, reports that the judge's decision in the lawsuit will be announced tomorrow.
- At 10:30 am, Pacific Standard Time, lawyer Ross Clark, will receive the decision and the judge's reasons for that decision via email. He will send a quick email with the results, with a longer discussion of the decision to come later.
- Deborah advises, "The media are aware of the announcement coming tomorrow and are already clamoring for more information. We will do our best to accommodate their deadlines by mid-day. We understand the court will release the decision by posting it on its website by mid-afternoon. If media call you, you can direct them to me (see numbers and email below). If you elect to speak to media, please make sure you respond graciously and in your best, most hopeful and polite manner. Win or lose, we must all strive to be sportsmanlike."
