### Accommodations for the Olympics

- The time is drawing near. If you are planning to attend the Olympics and haven't booked accommodation yet, this is a good time to start looking.
- Within our community there are folks who have booked accommodations who are looking for others to share with them. There are many on our email list that live in the Squamish/Whistler area and they may have friends and neighbours who have accommodations to rent.
- Though we will not make arrangements for you, we will add postings to future Updates. In your posting, please include as much information as you can and be sure to include an email address or phone number.
- If you are planning to stay in a camper/trailer, you may be interested to hear that the provincial park just south of Squamish has announced that it will be open during the games:

**October 13, 2009** (North Vancouver, BC Canada) – Porteau Cove and Cultus Lake Provincial Parks will be open early for camping during the 2010 Winter Olympic Games for the entire month of February to provide additional and affordable accommodation in the Lower Mainland.

Campers will have two options within provincial parks operated in the Lower Mainland area: Porteau Cove and Cultus Lake. Porteau Cove Provincial Park is located on the scenic waterfront of Highway 99 between Vancouver and Whistler. Cultus Lake located near Chilliwack, BC and approximately an hour and a half away from Vancouver.

Porteau Cove Provincial Park will open the drive-in and walk-in sites along with additional parking spots available for RVs only in the day-use parking lot. Rates for Porteau Cove will

range from \$10.00-\$35.00 per night. Electrical hookup fees at Porteau Cove are an extra \$8.00 per night.

Cultus Lake Provincial Park will open Delta Grove and Clear Creek campgrounds and charge \$28.00 per night with full toilet and shower facilities. All parking fees will be in effect for both parks and can be made payable upon arriving at the campground.

Reservations for Cultus Lake and Porteau Cove for February 2010 will begin on Tuesday, October 13, 2009 at 9:00 AM PST by calling 604-986-9371 or by email at, [info@seatoskyparks.com](mailto:info@seatoskyparks.com). A reservation fee of \$25.00 will apply for each reservation. The bookings for February 2010 will run independently from the Discover Camping reservations that occur in the summer camping months.
