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The Altius Nordic Ski Club programs are open to any young athlete looking for a program that combines cross country skiing, ski jumping and cross-training with a major focus on fitness and body awareness.

1.0 Registration for Programs

Participants in Ski Jumping and/or Nordic Combined programs based at Canada Olympic Park or facilitated by Altius Nordic Ski Club (ANSC) require:

- 1.1 Current Altius Nordic Ski Club (ANSC) registration
- 1.2 Current Alberta Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined (ASJNC) registration
- 1.3 Current Ski Jumping Canada (SJC) and/or Nordic Combined Ski Canada (NCSC) registration
- 1.4 Provision of up-to-date emergency contact information
- 1.5 Completion of an up-to-date Winsport Canada Olympic Park waiver
- 1.6 For the winter session, a valid Canada Olympic Park Downhill ski pass or year-round pass is required
- 1.7 Completion of up-to-date waivers as required by venue operators while at other venues
- 1.8 Purchase of day or season passes as required by venue operators while at other venues

2.0 Registration for Competitions

Participants in Ski Jumping and/or Nordic Combined competitions hosted by Altius Nordic Ski Club (ANSC) require:

- 2.1 Current registration with ANSC or an organization recognized by ANSC
- 2.2 Current registration with ASJNC or an organization recognized by ANSC
- 2.3 Current registration with SJC and/or NCSC or a National Sport Organization recognized by ANSC
- 2.4 Completion of an up-to-date waiver as required by the venue operator
- 2.5 Purchase of day or season passes as required by the venue operator
- 2.6 Arrangements for a responsible coach recognized by ANSC

3.0 Registration/Membership/Competitor Card Fees

- 3.1 ANSC Registration/Membership fee is currently \$25/year
- 3.2 ASJNC,SJC,NCC Registration/Membership fee is currently \$1/year each.
- 3.3 SJC/NCSC registration/Competitor Card fees
 - Domestic Competitor fee is currently \$20.00
 - International Competitor fee is currently \$100.00

4.0 Program Fees

Fees for Altius Nordic Ski Club (ANSC) programs are reviewed each year in June by the Altius Nordic Ski Club Board of Directors to set annual fees effective with the fall session. At the present time the Hopper program fees are set to achieve a revenue-neutral budget.

ANSC Program Fee Schedule for 2013/14:

- Fall: \$625.00
- Winter: \$1,150
- Spring: \$600 (2013) \$625 (2014)
- Summer: \$1,100 for 5 weeks, or \$300/ week. (2013). \$1,150 for 5 weeks or \$325/week (2014)

Note: Program Fees do not include fees associated with any trips (e.g. Park City)

5.0 Trip Fees

Trips facilitated by Altius Nordic Ski Club are typically budgeted on a revenue-neutral basis. Participants will be advised of fees related to trips that they may choose to participate in.

6.0 Competition Fees

Altius Nordic Ski Club typically requires payment of nominal competition fees. Athletes invited to participate in such competitions will be advised of the competition fee in advance.

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7.0 Payments

- 7.1 Registration/Membership and Program Fees are payable upon receipt of the invoice or at sign up for programs.
 - 7.2 Trip Fees are payable upon receipt of invoice - prior to trip departure.
 - 7.3 Competition Fees are payable upon submission of the competition registration – prior to the competition
 - 7.4 Equipment Fees (if any) are payable upon receipt of invoice. At present, equipment fees may be assessed for cross-country equipment associated with winter program participation.(see below)
 - 7.5 All fees must be paid in full or alternate arrangements made prior to participation in a session.
 - 7.6 First time registrants will be given a 2 week trial period and allowed to withdraw from the program free of charge. Any athlete that stays past the 2 week trial will responsible for the full fees for that session.
- Note:** Athlete's first and last name must be on the cheque to avoid any confusion with the payment.

8.0 Refunds

- 8.1 Registration/Membership fees are non-refundable
- 8.2 Under normal circumstances, program fees are non-refundable.
- 8.3 For exceptional circumstances, requests for ANSC program fee refunds may be submitted to the ANSC Board of Directors for consideration through the head coach.

9.0 Equipment

- 9.1 ANSC will do its best to provide each Athlete with proper fitting Ski Jumping skis, boots and a jumping suit from our inventory.
- 9.2 Athletes will require a helmet and goggles suitable for ski jumping
 - Athletes are encouraged to provide their own helmet.
 - ANSC will provide a helmet from our inventory for the first year of program participation
 - Goggles are the athlete's responsibility
- 9.3 Cross country skis, boots and poles will be required for the winter session
 - Athletes are encouraged to provide their own cross-country equipment
 - ANSC will provide cross-country equipment for the first winter session at no charge from our inventory.
 - After the first year in the program ANSC may provide cross-country equipment from our inventory for a fee of \$100.00 if available.
- 9.4 Additional equipment may be required for cross-training (e.g. roller blades, mountain bike)
- 9.5 Parents will be responsible for the following:
 - Keeping the ski jumping suits clean, and repair tears, zippers, etc.
 - Replacing any boot laces or Velcro straps that become broken
 - Replacement costs for any equipment that is lost, intentionally damaged, or returned in poor condition
- 9.6 ANSC is not responsible for loss or damage of any personal items.

10.0 Volunteer Expectations

- Parents are expected to volunteer for Casinos and fundraisers as organized by the Club.
- Parents are expected to participate in the running of local competitions
- Parents are also encouraged to volunteer for board positions with ANSC, ASJNC, SJC and NCSC

The success of our club is directly related to the contribution of our members.

11.0 Code of Conduct

All participants in ANSC programs are required follow the Altius Code of Conduct. The code of Conduct will reviewed and signed by the parents or guardian on or before the first day of training.
